Morning sessions:

- These sessions will primarily be written in tutor classes.
- Time:
 - o Report to tutor class for register and preparation: 7:30.

 - \circ Writing time: 08:00 09:00.
 - o Finishing time: 09:00.

Afternoon sessions:

- The subjects written in the afternoon require more than 1 hour and will be written after school.
- The morning sessions will therefore be used by learners to prepare for the assessment.
- Time:
 - o Report to venue for register and preparation: 14:25.
 - Reading time: 14:30 14:40.
 - Starting time: 14:40 completion.

Rules and Regulations

- All learners will be seated in the venue during the test period. Learners not writing a formal assessment in a specific session will be granted study-time to prepare for other upcoming assessments. In some Grade 10 12 subjects, the learners will be divided into groups and venues for that specific session. These venues and lists will be made available prior to the assessment.
- All learners must be on time for the assessment session. If you are late, no additional time will be allocated.
- You must not assist, try to assist, or communicate with anybody during the assessment session. Any questions must be directed to the invigilator.
- You may not create a disturbance in the venue, or behave in an improper or unseemly manner.
- You may not have any material which may be of help to you in the venue, other than that which was provided to you by the invigilator.
- Only calculators, as approved and prescribed, may be used in the assessment. Calculators must be free from the case at all times.
- You may not take, use, borrow, or receive anything from any other candidate.
- Under no circumstances may any electronic device be used; especially phones or smart-watches.
- If you fail to adhere to these rules, you will be liable to a hearing.
